WSC made their first score midway in the first period on a pass interception. Eggers had punted 44 yards out of bounds on the Idaho 1 foot line.

In the second quarter Idaho stopped a sustained WSC drive on the Vandal 7. Later in the quarter Lippincott smashed off guard from the Idaho 8 to make the second WSC score.

Early in the fourth quarter the Cougars advanced to the Idaho 16, but Ringgenberg's recovery of Rosse's fumble on the Idaho 33 ended the scoring threat for awhile.
