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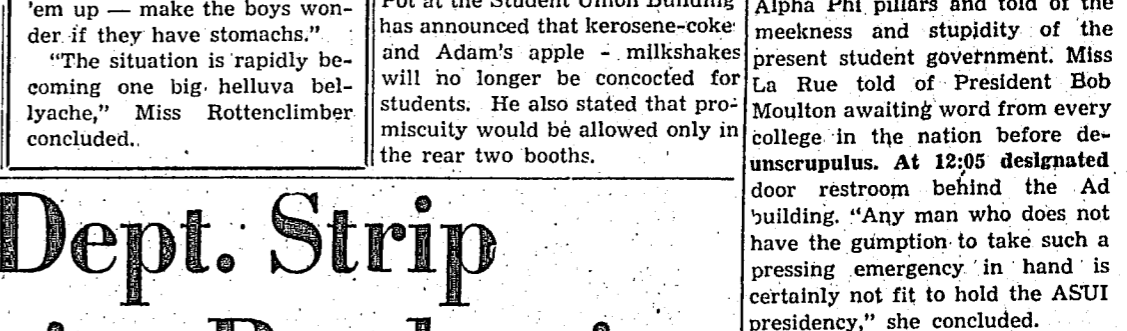

## Profs Work Shady Deal

The announcement by the faculty that final examinations will be eliminated in the future has brought a few murmured protests. When the masses learn of the full implications of the plan, these few will be the voice of thousands.

Anticipating that it would be at least a week earlier, the student wanted to make arrangements for a summer job. The tunnel will be equipped with special sun lamps the first nine months to enable prisoners to adjust their eyes to the Northern Idaho weather when they are released.

 More than 100,000 trees have been ordered this winter by Idaho farmers utilizing services of the University of Idaho forest nursery and the extension forester. The trees are used as windbreaks and for woodlots as well as in landscaping.



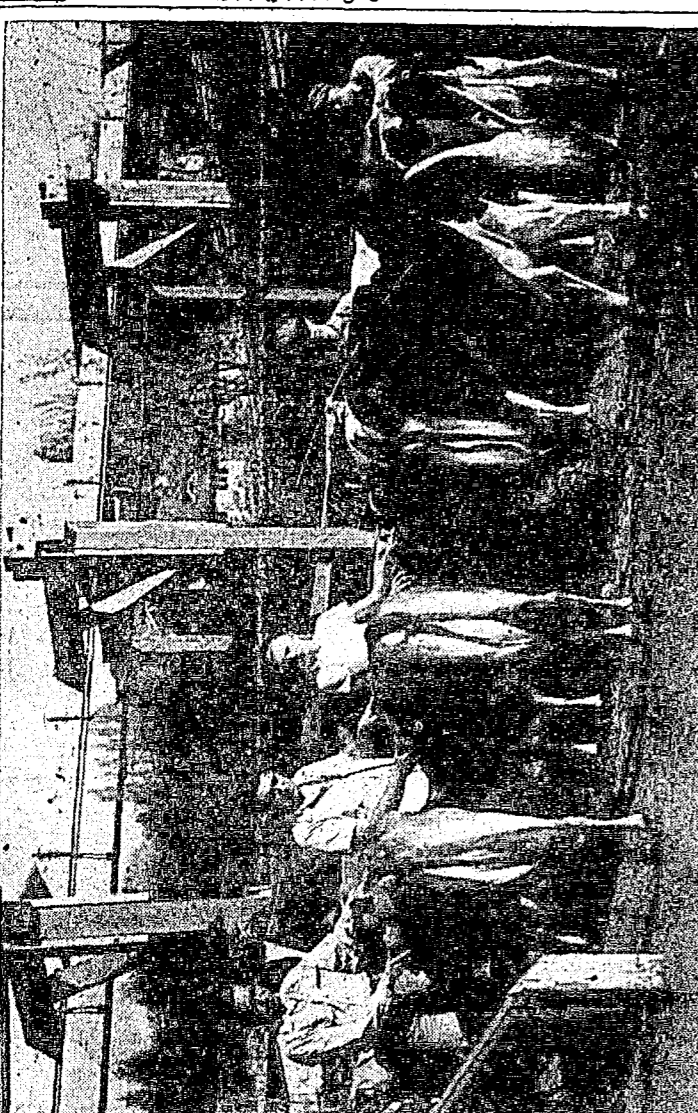

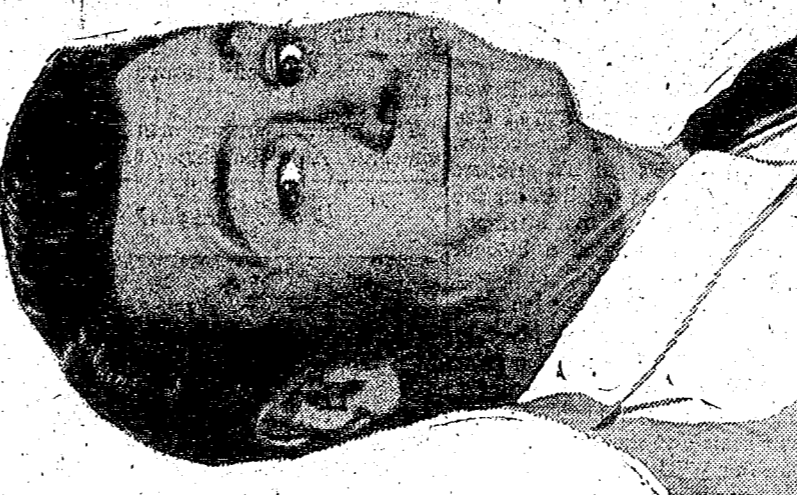
