



### Center to hold depression screening

Depression is one the most treatable of all medical illnesses, according to a poster for National Depression Screening Day, to be held in Moscow this Thursday.

"It's so treatable, a lot of people think it's just a weakness," cautioned Sharon Fritz, the coordinator for Outreach Services for the Student Counseling Center at the University of Idaho.

"Sixty-eight percent of students who make contact with our office indicate that depression is some kind of an issue for them. About 42 percent indicated that it was a significant issue for them," she said, and added that the Center sees about eight to 10 percent of the student body.

"The symptoms are really familiar," she said. Professor Joan Pulakos, a licensed psychiatrist with the Center agreed.

Depressed people generally have a difficult time getting motivated, have trouble in classes, and even problems getting up in the morning, Pulakos said. She added that some also have suicidal thoughts.

The screening test that the Center uses was designed by a Harvard psychiatrist, continued Fritz. It is a quiz of 13 questions that ask about the subject's energy level, emotional state, and self esteem during the past two weeks. "I think it's really accurate in terms of indicating if there's depression," she said.

"It's sort of a way for them to assess themselves. Just information Association, and the National about it [depression] in general," said Pulakos. After the test is taken said. and evaluated, psychologists from

the center talk to the person who took the test, and may make a referral for treatment if it is deemed nec-

"The treatment of choice is counseling and medication," Fritz said. "Our goal is to educate people so they know what's happening and address the situational issues."

"I've seen people go from being really suicidal to feeling much better and excited about life again," said Pulakos, a second time screener.

Fritz said that the test will also screen for manic depression (sometimes called bipolar disorder) and Seasonal Affective Disorder.

All of the questions can be answered quickly, and the total time needed to take the test and receive evaluation is 15 minutes, Fritz estimated.

'They're not going to have to wait in line," said Fritz, who has been helping to facilitate Screening Day for three years.

Screening Day is open to all members of the community. It will take place outside of the Appaloosa Lounge in the Student Union Building. Questions about the Screening Day or about making an appointment with the Student Counseling Center can be answered at 885-6716. All of the center's services are free.

National Depression Screening Day is an awareness day coordinated by a company in California and sponsored by several national psychiatric associations such as the American Psychiatric Association, the National Mental Health Alliance for the Mentally Ill, Fritz

#### Y2K monster defeated by Information Technology Services

The University of Idaho will fare much better than corporate America in dealing with the impact of the new millennium on computers, said Chuck Lanham, associate director of Information Technology Services (ITS). A Year 2000 Task Force has completed the assessment process and will use these findings to correct the problems associated with the if such errors are not taken care of. year 2000 software problem.

"The Year 2000 Task Force is composed of nine people and has just completed a campuswide assessment of departments on campus," Lanham said. Lanham said the next step will be to take these results and resolve the problems before the year

The "Millennium Bug," or Y2K problem, occurs in computer systems which use a two-digit field to identify years. Many current programs automaticly assume the first two digits to be 19. The problem arises when the computer will not accept or wrongly interprets the last two digits of the date 2000 as if it were the year 1900.

"The Y2K problem affects not only personal computers," Lanham said, "but also lab equipment, security systems, heating and air conditioning units and elevators."

The UI uses a system called Banner, which Lanham said is safe from the Y2K problem. Banner is relied upon by both students and administrators for such purposes as storing students' grades and academic transcripts. It is also used in the online registration process. "Once we review the results of the survey, we will get to work on solving Y2K problems in departments throughout the campus," Lanham said.

It is estimated that the Y2K issue will cost US industry four trillion Lanham said any program that dollars to assess and correct. #### Seiffert looks to unseat the S of S

Jerry Seiffert faces a formidable challenge this election, or perhaps challenges. Seiffert is running for Idaho Secretary of State against Pete Cenarrusa, who has held the office for the last 31 years.

Not only must Seiffert defeat the 81-year-old Cenarrusa, he must inform voters that Secretary of State is an elected position. Cenarrusa has held the position so long, many have never known a different secretary. Thirdly, Seiffert is running on a complex platform that focuses mainly on the Idaho Land Board.

The Land Board is mandated by the state constitution to oversee Idaho's state lands. The proceeds from sale or lease of these lands are funneled into a permanent endowment fund. From there, the State Treasurer distributes the money first to Idaho schools.

Seiffert, former mayor of Ketchum, said in an Argonaut interview last week he will focus on keeping public lands public and ending the over-protection of ranchers' grazing interests in lease contracts.

"Pete has been a staunch defender of grazing rights," Seiffert said of his opponent. He said that the time has come to force ranchers to compete for the leases, rather that treat them as if they had a right to the

"What you don't want to get into is making people believe that they have a proprietary interest that they're supposed to have," he said.

Ranchers in Idaho have traditionally raised livestock on leased public land, but in recent years have seen an increase in interest in the land.

"You can't do both," said Seiffert. "You can't defend an economic interest that you're negotiating with and at the same time negotiate the best deal possible for your constituency," who Seiffert said are the children of Idaho.

"If someone doesn't start screaming and hollering and storm out of the room once or twice, you haven't got a good deal," he said.

He also said that public land should not be sold if it can be avoided. We need to keep public lands public, he said.

The Land Board, however, has five voting members of which the Secretary of State is only one. The Governor, the Attorney General, State Controller, and Superintendent

#### MO college will not sanction gay group

LIBERTY, Mo. (AP) - Insistence by the president of William Jewell College that the religious-based school will not sanction a student gay and lesbian group is seen as hypocritical by some students.

Those students told college administrators last spring they were interested in making a formal proposal for such an organization.

But President Christian Sizemore said this summer the school with Southern Baptist roots would not "provide recognition, endorsement or funds" for a gay and lesbian student club.

"To do so would be contrary to our mission and purposes, which are deeply rooted in Baptist traditions," Sizemore said in "Word & Way," a weekly publication of the Missouri Baptist Convention.

"Our goal as a college community is to uphold the standards of free inquiry, fairness and understanding," Sizemore said later in a news release. "Our students cannot and should not be artificially isolated from people or ideas."

But, he continued, "tolerating debate or discussion about a controversial issue of this nature does not imply endorsement of homosexuality or homosexual lifestyles."

Student advocates of such a group derided the decision.

"It didn't surprise me, but it does disappoint me," said junior Laura Bryan. "They preach Christian val-

ues and unconditional love and acceptance. Basically, I think they are being hypocritical.'

Last spring, several students approached Gary Phelps, the dean of student affairs, about establishing a group for gays and lesbians. Phelps leads a faculty-student committee that recognizes student clubs.

But the groups did not make a for-

mal proposal last year. Students are free to discuss the topic and organize an independent group, said college spokesman

Raymond Jones. Despite that freedom, Bryan said, Jewell's hands-off policy isn't comforting. She fears reprisals against any gay and lesbian group operating without college sanction.

Mark Cadd, director of Jewell's Center for Academic Diversity, organized two symposiums about homosexuality last year. He later offered to be a staff adviser for a gay and lesbian group.

Cadd said the recent decision was disappointing at the liberal arts institution. Funding concerns, he said, could be the administration's prime motivation. Jewell receives about \$1 million a year from the Missouri Baptist Convention.

"Money is what matters at this college and any other," Cadd said.

In response, Jones said "the president and the trustees do what they feel is in the best interests of the institution."

He would not comment further.







of Public Instruction also vote on the board.

But Seiffert is confident that Controller J.D. Williams, previously the only Democrat on the board, will be re-elected. He also thinks Marilyn Howard, running against Republican Anne Fox, stands a good chance of being elected.

But even with just Williams, Seiffert is confidant. "If you get two more of us (Democrats) on the state Land Board, that's an amazing turn around in one part of state govern-

Seiffert said that Cenarrusa was planning on retirement, but decided to run again when he learned that Gov. Phil Batt would not appoint his suggestion for the office. That, said Seiffert, turned some voters against Cenarrusa. He takes pride in at least attracting the incumbent's attention.

"I think we've got a better shot than people realize," said Seiffert.

Nevertheless, Cenarrusa has not lost an election in three decades, and Seiffert is an underdog.

The office carries a four-year term.

#### UN General Assembly debate actually produces some moves towards peace

UNITED NATIONS (AP) - With a global economic crisis looming and conflicts creating turmoil in more than 30 hotspots, world leaders came to the United Nations over the past two weeks and made some surprising moves towards easing global tensions.

After detonating nuclear devices in May, India and Pakistan announced plans to adhere to the nuclear test ban treaty within the next year, which would slow the South Asian arms race.

Benjamin Netanyahu announced Israel will shortly hand over 13 percent of the West Bank to the Palestinians, and Yasser Arafat backed down from unilaterallly declaring that a Palestinian state would be in place by May 4, 1999, the deadline for implementing the Middle East peace accords.

Iran's moderate government distanced itself from a dlrs 2.5 million reward for killing Salman Rushdie, author of "The Satanic

Verses" which religious leaders claimed blasphemed Islam, from Western ministers.

Nigeria's new leader, Gen. Abdulsalam Abubakar, committed his military government to fair elections and a return to civilian rule next year, key Western demands to end the country's pariah status.

Still, many of the world's conflicts showed no signs of cooling

There was no progress on reunification of Cyprus, divided since 1974 when Turkey occupied the north of the island nation. The border conflict between Ethiopia and Eritrea remained tense. Congo accused neighboring Rwanda and Uganda of invading the country and massacring thousands of innocent Congolese. Rwanda and Uganda denied the allegations and blamed Congo for slaughtering innocent men, women and chil-

And the threat of NATO military strikes against Serb targets in Kosovo grew, following the

broadcast and publication of gruesome pictures of massacred ethnic prompting a positive response Albanians Survivors blamed Serb forces trying to crush independence-seeking ethnic Albanians.

The U.N. Security Council on Thursday condemned the massacres, but didn't assign blame or add any new legal backing for any NATO action.

Yugoslav Foreign Minister Zivadin Jovanovic denied any new attacks in Kosovo and insisted his country wanted "direct, unconditional" dialogue with the ethnic Albanians - which they have rejected - to resolve the conflict peacefully.

Old Cold War opponents still shouted at each other.

North Korea, the most rigid remaining communist state, accused its South Korean rivals of being "running dogs" of the Americans. And the Cubans and Americans volleyed in the assembly debate for two rounds over the U.S. embargo and the refusal of the Western hemisphere's only communist state to hold democratic elections.

With a new millennium just two years away, many leaders wondered aloud how the international community can deal with the issues heaped on the global plate from the growing number of conflicts in Africa to the growing gap between rich and poor and the growing threat of international terrorism.

"Mankind is increasingly feeling the breathing of the 21st century," said Russian Foreign Minister Igor Ivanov.

Nations will live "in peace and harmony" once they recognize their interdependence and start to seek collective responses to the challenges of the time, he said.

Eager to forge a more collective response, many nations suggested ways for reforming the U.N. Security Council to make it more representative of the world - and more responsive to the needs of developing countries. But talk of expanding the council - effectively the U.N. board of directors - is hopelessly stalled over who should get to join the exclusive

#### Urinating in aisle gets man 19 months

GREENSBORO, NC (AP) - A man got 19 months in prison for picking fights during an airline flight and urinating in the aisle.

Walter Andrew Everhart, 36, told a federal judge Monday that he remembered none of the episode, saying painkillers and alcohol caused him to black out during the US Airways flight from Germany to Philadelphia last November.

He also did not recall kicking the seat of a pregnant woman so hard that she fell out and feared she would have a miscarriage.

Witnesses said it took six Polish police officers to subdue Everhart after he urinated into a condom and became unruly.


"I cannot imagine a more volatile situation than what occurred on that flight," US District Judge Frank Bullock Jr. said.

#### Apathetic students: rise up and make your voice heard

Kudos to the Students for Environmental Action Coalition (SEAC) and Brian Peterson for getting a great new resolution passed in the ASUI Senate to make Thursday, Oct. 8 the official Voter Registration Day at the University of Idaho. That's right, eight percent! That is the most ridiculous thing I've ever heard, especially occurring in a country whose system of representative democracy is the beacon of liberty for the rest of the world. Could it be that one day we will have to just call off this whole democracy thing because the citizens were all just too busy to vote? Watch a little C-SPAN, didates participate in here on campus, or tune in to KUOI to listen to County Commission, Idaho House of Representatives and Idaho Senate candidates being aired Oct. 8, 13, 21 and 28. Each show begins at 6:30 p.m., and listeners can call in and ask the candidates questions about issues on their minds. What a great opportunity to hear from the candidates and participate in elections at the state level. Also, I would like to encour age the UI faculty to help out in their classes on Voter Registration Day, handing out voter registration cards and informing students of the issues.

I like to try new things, but I am skeptical about the prospects of my developing a craving for raw fish. Most Fins take a bag to the store because you are charged for each bag. This is a good way to reduce unnecessary consumption. I

approve. It is great that bike paths parallel most significant roadways in Finland, and that the public transportation system is very efficient and effective. This is an area where the United States is woefully lacking, and could benefit from some imitation. It annoys me greatly that our cities and towns are planned assuming that everyone has a car! Communities where one can survive and function without a car are rare. That is one great aspect of living in Moscow, Idaho.

A similarity between countries is that the vast forest lands are mainly used for industrial purposes, and most of you know that I strongly dis-

A notable difference here is the police. They tend to truly "serve and protect," rather than harass and persecute. The drinking age of 18 is rarely enforced, even when teens drink openly in the streets. Compare this to the violent gestapo tactics used at WSU last spring on otherwise legal adults.

A senior from Belgrade, Mont., Moore has been raising havoc against opposing players since her red-shirt freshman year in 1995 when she helped the Vandals to their third straight NCAA tournament.

Moore was born in Seattle, Wash. and moved to Belgrade at the age of

Her family was a basketball one, and that is what she grew up playing.

As a freshman at Belgrade High School, Moore went out for the volleyball team only because her friends were doing the same thing.

Despite her lack of knowledge of

the game, she made the freshman team. Within four weeks of volleyball, she was playing on the varsity team.

As her high school career continued she began to gain a love for the game of volleyball that

matched and surpassed her love for basketball.

Recruited mainly as a basketball player coming out of high school, Moore went against what many of her relatives and friends believed she would do. She decided to come to the University of Idaho and play volleyball.

"I was on my own, and I took full advantage of that," Moore stated.

Then head coach Tom Hilbert had enough of Moore's academic struggle and told her to pack her stuff up and leave.

"I called him and basically begged him to not get rid of me. We talked about it and at that point I kicked myself into gear and started doing better in school," said Moore.

Hilbert then left to coach at Colorado State, the new transition was tough on Moore to learn the system on current head coach Carl Ferreira.

'Carl runs a completely different offense and defense than I had ever ran. New coaches have different techniques for blocking and hitting. It was like I was a freshman again,

Ferreira coaches with his wife

Ellen Bugalski-Ferreira and Jared Sliger. The Ferreiras have two kids that are with them all of the time.

"It was more of a family atmosphere, which I think helped. I am a family person and am very close with my family, and that helped me warm up to the coaches," said Moore.

Moore has had many heart to heart talks with her coaches and believes that the personal approach they have with the team makes them a stronger unit.

Through all of the hardships Moore has battled, she still puts up great numbers and will be known as one of the best middle blockers in school history.

The numbers before this season speak for themselves; ninth all-time in school history with 1,038 kills, fourth in block assists with 326, eighth all-time in digs with 795, and has played in 78 straight matches since 1995.

Moore is one the team leaders for the Vandals. She plays with emotion and leads both vocally and by example.

It is this combination of charisma and skill that makes Jessica Moore a player to watch.

### Idaho humiliates Bengals for homecoming

After playing the role of underdog on the road three weeks in a row, Idaho returned to the Kibbie Dome and beat up on Idaho State with a 52-3 win. The Vandals dominated the line of scrimmage, rushing the ball almost at will, while nearly defense was impenetrable.

Idaho kicked off to open the game and Idaho State promptly gave the ball back as they fumbled on their own 11 yard-line on the second play. Joel Thomas took the ball on the first play from scrimmage and ran untouched through the Bengal defense for the touchdown.

ISU put up a fight in the first quarter as they put together a nice drive and kicker Pete Garces launched a field goal just over the cross bar from 53 yards out.

The Vandals then took control, led by the inspired play of Thomas. Jeffrey Townsley gave Idaho excellent field position with a kickoff return to the 44 yard-line.

After catching a 16-yard pass, Thomas electrified the audience of over 15,000 with a 19 yard run. After scampering outside down the left sideline, Thomas cut back all the way across the field, but stumbled in the open field. The appreciative fans gave Thomas an ovation as he left

the field after the play. "I'm going to have to talk to the Dome maintenance guys and see why the paint on that line was so thick," Thomas said, jokingly referring to why he fell down.

The Thomas run set up a touchdown pass to tight end Geoff Franks from John Welsh.

Thomas had a huge day with two touchdowns and 168 yards on 19 carries. In the second quarter, Thomas displayed his versatility completing a 57-yard pass to Ryan Prestomonico. It was the first pass he has ever thrown in six years at Idaho and set up a six-yard touchdown catch by Michael Moody from Welsh.

"I'm running out of things to say about Joel. He's obviously a great football player and his effort and leadership are what is getting this team going in the right direction," Coach Chris Tormey said of according to Thomas. The line also gave Welsh time in the pocket, as he completed nine of 16 passes for 158 yards and three touchdowns.

Idaho's tight ends each had big days as Travis Stombaugh made a diving catch in the end zone in the third quarter. Welsh completed the 34-yard touchdown pass with a Bengal defender hanging on his leg.

On the defensive side, Idaho completely shut down the Bengal running game and allowed ISU just six first downs the entire game. After rushing for nearly 300 yards last week against Portland State, ISU managed just 62 against the Vandals.

"We've been in some games where we've had a big lead at halftime and we've come out in the third quarter and haven't put people away. We did that tonight and a big part of it was because of what the offensive line did up front and our defensive front too," Tormey said.

As Idaho extended their lead to 45-3 by the end of the third quarter, the large crowd began to thin out.

The running game was keyed by the most since the 1995 Boise State the play of the offensive line, game. The margin of victory was also the highest since a 66-3 win over Sonoma State in 1995.

Tormey was pleased with his team's effort, and said after the first quarter, they played the way they should. Tormey said despite lopsided Idaho wins the last two years, the series with ISU is good for the state.

"I think it's good for us to go down there and play every other year. We have an awful lot of fans in southeastern Idaho, and it's good for us to have visibility down there. I think for every LSU you play, you need to play an Idaho State.'

ISU head coach Tom Walsh wasn't as positive about the series and said games against Idaho aren't necessarily good for his program at this point. He said his team played uninspired football, but gave Idaho

credit for playing well. Idaho will again travel down south next week as they play Arkansas State. The Indians will join the Big West Conference next year and should give Idaho a good test before their showdown with

He then established himself as one of Hollywood's foremost directors.

As producer Frank Mancuso Jr. puts it, "He made the template" for political thrillers with Seven Days in May and The Manchurian Candidate, now regarded as classics. His works also encompassed social dramas (Birdman of Alcatraz, All Fall Down) and action pictures (Grand Prix).

In the '70s, though, he ran into some personal difficulties, including a drinking problem, which followed the assassination of close friend Robert F. Kennedy. Kennedy was staying at Frankenheimer's house, and Frankenheimer drove him to the Ambassador Hotel the night he was killed in 1968.

Frankenheimer lost his touch, making such clunkers as Prophecy, The Challenge, Dead-Bang and Year of

What do you get when you cross Woody Allen with an ant? One very funny movie.

"Antz," a computer-animated feature from DreamWorks Pictures and PDI, is a delightful blend of Allenesque verbal humor and a clever, insect-eye view of the world.

Woody Allen fans will find plenty of their hero in Z (voiced by Allen), who is dissatisfied with being a worker ant. His colony is a Dilbert version of hell: hordes of ants doing mindless work, driven not by whips and chains but by culture and heavy-handed management techniques.

At one point, they must swarm together to form a wrecking ball. Their foreman (voiced by Grant Shaud, in a role reminiscent of his

Miles Silverberg on TV's "Murphy Brown") tries to motivate them with a New Age-ish mantra: "Be the ball!"

Z falls in love with the colony's Princess Bala (voiced by Sharon Stone) and, just to see her again, he crosses a forbidden social divide to become a soldier ant. He unwittingly becomes a war hero and threatens to block the evil plan of General Mandible (voiced by Gene Hackman), who wants to kill all the workers. In the end, Z shows true courage and organizes his fellow workers in a bold stroke that saves them all.

The screenplay, by Todd Alcott and Chris and Paul Weitz, gives Z lines that ring true for Allen as insect. The movie opens with Z in a psychotherapy session, complaining that as the middle child in a family of several million, he never got any attention. When some fellow insects interrupt his tete-a-tete with Princess Bala to ask a favor, Z grumbles, "Ever wonder why they call you guys pests?"



#### Effective Resumes, the key to a successful career fair

An effective resume should provide a potential employer with an easy to understand list of the qualifications that set you apart from other applicants. The goal of a resume is to highlight selling points that will get the job seeker an inter-

"The first step before actually writing a resume is to gain an understanding of what the employer needs," said Dan Blanco, director of Career Services at the University of Idaho. This helps the applicant tailor the resume to a particular company's needs, he said. This also shows the employer that you are enthusiastic about the position they are offering.

A chronological resume with most recent education and work experience listed first is recommended for the college resume, name, address, phone number and e-mail address should be provided. An objective clearly stating the position you are seeking should also be included, although it is considered optional. Avoid general

statements in your objective, such as, "I am seeking a challenging position in a progressive company."

graduate. At the top of the Headings should be clearly labeled using bold letters to stand out. Under the education heading, indicate the degree earned, your date of graduation, as well as major area of study. Grade-point-average should be included. Any addi-

tional training related to the job applied for can be described under the education heading.

The resume should look professional, and should be organized in a logical fashion.

The National Association of Colleges and Employers suggests using an easy-to-read font such as Times New Roman or Arial, at a point size of between 10 and 14. Use good quality paper in either white or a neutral shade such as light gray. The best length for a resume is one-page.

A resume serves as a first impression to an employer, so have at least two people proofread the resume to check for spelling and typographical errors. Since the average employer

looks at a resume for 20-30 seconds, it must not have obvious errors, according to Career Services. Blanco said, "A resume is the document used to put your best foot forward."

Employers are interested in a job applicant's qualifications, not in personal information such as, "I love to play the piano." Always avoid cliches such as, "I am a people person." Also, it is not appropriate to provide details such as race, height or marital status in



### Korean auto maker targets students

DECATUR, Ga.—To the hyperintensive world of college campus marketing, add a new twist \_ a classmate trying to sell you a car.

That's what South Korean car maker Daewoo Corp. envisions as the key to cracking the U.S. auto market as it aims to sell 80 percent of its three- model line to college students who have been talked into a dealership by their peers on campus.

The company calls these contract student workers "Daewoo campus advisers," or DCAs.

"I think it pretty much looks stellar on any resume," said Georgia Tech DCA Ian Trenbeath, rattling off a list of marketing, public relations, event-planning, "and even management" experience he's gaining from his work with

Daewoo

On Tuesday, Daewoo officially opened its first 15 U.S. dealerships, including one in Decatur. The company's American auto division is based in Marietta.

This summer, Daewoo flew 2,000 students \_ future DCAs \_ from about 400 schools to Seoul. The students toured the company's plant in Kunsan, learned about the company's goals and history and studied Korean culture.

Daewoo, a mammoth conglomerate that was founded by Kim Woo-Choong in 1967 as a textiles exporter, says campus advisers will earn about \$400 per car they help sell.

Chairman Kim was on hand Tuesday to cut the blue ribbon at the Decatur showroom and accepted a plaque and photo of the Atlanta skyline from Stan Turman, general manager of Daewoo of Decatur.

University of Georgia junior Thomas McGuinn was one of 20 people who won free use of a Daewoo for a year, selecting a top-of-the-line Leganza model from a large blue pot. Daewoo will be challenged not only by the glut of some 600 models U.S. car buyers face, but also by the fact that they are a company without a reputation in America.

As a result, consumers will rely heavily on magazine and other testing, said J. Ferron, a partner and auto analyst at PricewaterhouseCooper Accounting, and a former Daewoo consultant in South Korea.

"There's a lot of experimentation going on in the industry. Daewoo is one of those experiments," he said.



#### House Votes Lower Student Loan Interst Rates, Raise Student Grants

#### **Assoceated Press**

WASHINGTON- Sen. James Jeffords' bill that would lower interest rates on college student loans for all borrowers and raise the maximum student-aid grant passed the Senate on Tuesday. The bipartisan measure, originally sponsored by the Vermont Republican, now goes to President Clinton for his likely signature. The 96-0 vote followed voice-vote House approval Monday of the compromise bill

"This legislation gives millions of students the financial key to unlock the door to higher education," Jeffords said. "By lowering the interest rate for student loans to the lowest levels in nearly 20 years and by increasing the level of Pell grants, we are allowing higher-learning to mean higher-earnings for more of our children." The measure also includes incentives for people to become teachers by offering to forgive part of their student loans if they teach in urban or rural districts with large numbers of poor children. It also includes a grant program for



states to improve teacher preparation

And teacher-preparation colleges would have to provide information to would-be students about what percentage of graduates pass teacher examinations.

The measure is one of the few education bills to find bipartisan support this election year.

A key provision would change the way interest rates are determined for student loans.

The new formula, based on Treasury bill interest rates and added points, would hold down what students pay by giving a subsidy to lenders. As a result, the rate for students would be 7.46 percent for new loans \_ the lowest rate in 17 years \_ down from 8.23 percent last year, sponsors say.

The measure also would raise the maximum authorized amount for Pell Grants to \$4,500 a year in 1999-2000, up from \$3,000. The amount would gradually rise to \$5,800 in 2003-2004. An added provision would require the Department of Education to gather and publish information on college costs, including yearly increases in tuition and fees.
