Black Studies

I would like to have continuing assistance in funding support for the Black Literature course. As you remember, in 1970 \$1000 was assigned for books, speakers, and AV support. Last year \$500 was allocated and assigned to Dean Raunio in addition to his usual funds. The money was then administered through his office. Since funding is tighter, I think a more appropriate amount would be \$400 (the same as requested by Professor Rolland for the Black History course). This would be spent for visiting lecturers and Audio-visual services, including film rentals. Any remaining balance would go for acquisitions of basic Black Literature reference materials. I greatly appreciate your past support and believe continuing assistance is necessary to take advantage of the excellent speakers and AV materials (especially films) available. I would appreciate your assigning this fund to Dean Raunio to administered as he did last year.
