In response to your memo dated March 7, 1977, as has been the case in the past as well as in this particular instance, you have failed to gather the facts. I have continued to urge you to acquaint yourself with the facts before going off on tangents. If only you would have listened to my explanation regarding the process of selecting students for Minority Scholarships drawn up by the ASUI Senate, this memo would not be necessary.

On one occasion after the usual amount of difficulty that I normally experience in trying to get you in my office to discuss procedure with which you should be familiar, I was able to explain the selection process. On one other occasion at a meeting concerning the reorganization process of this office, I conveyed the latest ASUI Senate bill outlining specific student qualifications required for eligibility.

There should be no confusion in this office concerning the eligibility for scholarships. However, if you are still in a state of confusion regarding this matter, I remain available to explain to you once again the process for selection.
