#### PRELIMINARY STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

We the black students of the University feel the need for an organization which would:

1. Increase interrelationships between the Black and African students
2. Provide an atmosphere where black students could relate to each other (in terms of personal communication on points of common interest)
3. Help each other establish our personal goals and help each other attain them
4. Provide a structure through which we can express personal interest and concern
5. Establish a foundation through which future black students could use as a "home base"
6. Form a coalition between other black students (B.S.U.) throughout the area (Boise State University, W.S.U., Oregon University of Washington-Seattle)
7. Provide a voice in the senate which would relate black needs to student gov't
8. Provide information about the various services already available through which we could find help for our problems (personal and academic)
9. Provide needed assistance through which we could promote comradery and unity between Black students ie... Rides to social functions in the Moscow Pullman area, information about various functions, involvement in future functions
10. Establish links with other minority (third world organizations ie Chicano, Native American)

#### ORGANIZATIONAL AIMS

Try to see that black students get education and degree

Assist each other academically

(Notebook on each other field, experience, year in school so we can help each other in the way of tutoring service.)

- B. Counsel students in scheduling for classes
- C. Provide information in terms of courses - what it takes to graduate
- D. Make the students aware of the services offered them

II.

- A. Workshops - discussion of different topics dealing with black students
- B. Meeting twice a month
- C. Social functions and parties
- D. Publish a newsletter or journal
- E. Office of Minority Affairs (to establish within the organization...)
- F. Meeting of all other third world organizations on campus on a regular basis
- G. Attending meetings at W.S.U. - Communicate by writing the other Black Student Unions within the state

- G. To establish a working coalition with the B.S.U. in the state of Idaho and Washington
- H. To provide an input into the ASUI by expressing the problems of Black students
- I. To provide needed assistance to Black students and establish a comradeship among Black students
