Subject University Programs for Ethnic Minority Students

Date November 30, 1973

This is to confirm our meeting on Tuesday, December 5th at 2:00 p.m. in my office in which I would like us to discuss the following items:

1. I would like to request that each of you provide a brief summary of the services currently provided by your agency for ethnic minority students on the University of Idaho campus, or those considering the University of Idaho.
2. I would like then to discuss these services being provided and make sure that we are all tuned to each other's services in this area.
3. I would like to consider the possibility of making some recommendations, for change and/or improvement where needed in these particular areas.

The reason I am calling this session is that I am particularly interested in this area since I now have two staff members reporting to me who are working directly with minority students -- that being Santiago Estrada and Corky Bush. In addition, I am very interested in gaining as much knowledge about the services being provided in these areas so that I can, if necessary, make a more comprehensive presentation to Tom Richardson and other appropriate agencies concerning the budgetary and staffing needs necessary to provide the best possible services for ethnic minority students at the University of Idaho.
