Dear Members:

When the Black Student Union was assigned space in the south Canterbury unit over a year ago, we were all aware that we would have to plan against the day when that building would come down. Current plans are for both of the Canterbury units to be demolished in the summer of 1976. That block will be developed as an extension of the present People's Park rather than be used as a construction site.

I bring this to your attention at this time for two reasons. First, it is important that you be aware of this so that with Mr. Ramsey's assistance we can be discussing how to meet BSU's space needs when the Canterbury House is no longer available to us. Secondly, I would suggest that BSU keep close track of the types of activities it has conducted this year and which it will conduct next year so that we can be analytical in knowing exactly the kinds of activities it is sponsoring and conducting when it comes to allocating space.

University space has become increasingly tight and it will require all of our best efforts to do the proper planning required to relocate BSU activities. I will remain available to work with you, Mr. Ramsey, and any other interested parties in trying to solve these problems.
