Dr. Barnes and I have reviewed our requirements for the negro history course and have again discussed the question of outside talent. We have a number of persons in mind both regionally and nationally who might add some zest to the presentation of material but do not feel that we can communicate with anyone unless there is some commitment of funds. We are also interested in acquiring two films, one of which Mr. Lind might be able to pay for from current funds, the other for which no funds are immediately in sight. We have discussed in addition a paperback library (possibly to include reprints of many scholarly articles on timely topics) for which additional funds would be required.

Specifically we would like an absolute commitment as follows:
