Interview Questions:

What would your attitude or reaction be to:

- 1. A student who was gregarious, outgoing, and said to be reasonably intelligent by some of his or her professors but who seldom attended class, and somehow managed to "withdraw passing" at the latest possible moment from so many of his or her courses that this student only passed 3 or perhaps 6 credits a semester? And if this student, for the past three semesters drew substantial financial aid?
- 2. A situation as the above, except this student was described by some of his or her instructors as well as other University officials (such as persons in the Registrar's Office, the Financial Aids Office, etc.) as extremely shy? Perhaps a person who would get behind in his or her course work, be too embarrassed to ask for help, and so stay away from class?
- 3. What would your attitude be about working out a program which would not only help minority students with poor backgrounds, but some whites who have come from a small town in Idaho where the teaching staff was poor, and who were very much inadequately prepared?
