a. Get into the schools.

1. Survey to be done by Alan Rose.

2. Workshop for teacher credit. Dan Lenhard will talk to Education Dean Dale Gentry.

b. Seek a state Centennial Grant to fund erection of signs showing the location of the Minedoka Interment Center.

The group chose the Latah County Human Rights Taskforce as its official name. It will meet monthly in the evening. All churches will be invited to send official representatives.

3. Juntura Role regarding LCHR Taskforce. Committee discussion resulted in the unanimous motion that the Committee to the following:

a. Attend meetings

b. Provide the liaison with the campus.

- c. Lend official support for the HCHR Taskforce activities.
- d. Send a letter of support from the Juntura Committee to the Taskforce.
- 4. Juntura Activities for the 1988-1989 Year. The committee recommends to its successors that it:
 - a. Address the coverage of minority students and events in the local press. This rose from a discussion of the sensational reportage of Black students' experiences with the universities on the Palouse.
 - b. Encourage new students by assigning all committee members and more Friendly Faculty to be contacts for new minority students before they arrive.
 - c. The first meeting of the 1988-89 year should be a joint meeting with the members from this year and next to provide some continuity.
