

JUNTURA COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

February 20, 1974, noon, SUB

The minutes of the meeting of February 13, 1974, were approved.

The Chairman introduced the new student member of the Juntura Committee, Kimi Kondo.

There were three proposals before the Committee to be acted on—the Advisory Program, the Position Paper, and the request for a Graduate Assistant. After some discussion concerning the Advisory Program, the title was changed to Ethnic/Disadvantaged Student Academic Advisory Program.

It was MSC that the Juntura Committee accept the Advisory Program as amended and give the Chairman the authority to put the program in final form and send it to Faculty Council.

The second proposal was the position paper. There was some discussion and several paragraphs on the last page were deleted. Ms. Bush was to check with Dr. Barber for input and prepare a final draft.

The request for a graduate assistant will be discussed at the next meeting.

Dave Capers, a representative from the Black Student Union, was present to offer some input to the committee. He stated that B.S.U. would like to have a greater voice in the development of programs and the Chairman informed him that input was welcome at any time.
