This is to inform you that signed copies of the enclosed petitions were presented to Academic Vice President Walter Steffens on Wednesday, October 23, 1968.

The petition requesting that Anthropology 158, "Race Problems," be taught during the coming Spring Semester received 607 signatures. The petition requesting that the History Department offer a course in Negro History received 454 signatures. We feel that this response indicates a significant demand for the institution of these courses.

We urge that this matter be given prompt consideration, and we hope that immediate action be taken to offer these courses as soon as possible.
