I am making enquiries for a small compressor, either new or second hand, so that I may be in position to get one, should it be found necessary to do so. Of course we should keep the tunnel running with what power we have as long as possible, but I considered it more important to get full output from the mine for the purpose of easing up the financial end of the business, than to keep the tunnel going. Still, if we can get a small compressor for temporary use, it will not be necessary to stop work at the tunnel at all.
