Dear Sir,

Herewith I hand you the usual reports for the W.E. 7th inst.

At the mine we have resumed work on Concentrating ore, with a force of about 220 men all told. The ore being mined is of good grade. There is nothing of fresh interest to report as to the condition of the mine - except that the Inyer ore continues to improve. If the Skookum ore body makes to the East, as suggested in my letter this morning - it is not improbable that our Inyer ore is the top of it.

At the mill we started the Eastside on the 1st, but adjustments and changes found necessary caused the loss of between 2 + 3 days. It is now running quite steadily, and with one or two little changes I believe it will handle 350 to 400 tons of ore a day.
