Replying to your letter dated Phoenix, B.C. Sept. 4th. J.E. Fortin has returned to Wardner, and has been to see me in regard to his Klondyke stock. He wants \$700 for 256,000 shares, the same that he offered you at \$500 when at Phoenix. You appear to have misunderstood his statement regarding B. Presley's stock, as the latter is not willing to take \$100. This was the sum which "he would have sold his interest for three years ago," but he wants more now. Fortin says that he can get us 555,000 shares for \$5000, which, of course, is an absurd proposition. I do not think we can do anything with this matter at present.
