I have your several favors of 26th and 27th ult. on above subject, all of which have attention. In the matter of showing the Stemwinder side lines on Sandow's cross sections, Because the end lines are laid obliquely across the strike of the vein, while the sections are at right angles to the strike, it would only be possible to show both side lines on two of the sections. On the other two, the sections planes cross one side and one end line, and if these lines were shown, it would make it appear that the vein was wider than the claim. I will not therefore make any changes in these maps until I have had an opportunity to call Lindley's attention to the matter.
