Enclosed find the usual reports for the week ending 21<sup>st</sup> inst.

Everything at the mine is progressing satisfactorily, and while there is very little change to note in the appearance of the stopes, that change is for the better.

Exploration work is confined to the Tyler ground. where the wing was sunk 8 ft. and the West drift and King & cut were each advanced 8 ft.

As intimated in my last weekly letter the ground at the Tunnel was getting bad again. It proved to be worse than anticipated, and the progress for the week was only 1 ft. It is running ground, and wetter than it has been at any point heretofore.
