Dear Sir,-

I have your letter of 19th inst. on the above subject, and note the time at which our case will probably come up.

In regard to the maps. I have tracings of four of them in the office here, and will have blue prints made today or tomorrow, and send to you. Another one will be completed in a day or two. This will leave two maps, Nos. 3 and 4 to be made, and they cannot be made until the underground survey of the Last Chance works is completed. I note that Judge Beatty has granted a revival of the former order for survey, and presume that the order will reach me within a day or so. I telegraphed to Judge Lindley yesterday enquiring about it. I do not think there will be any delay in the completion of the maps and model.

I note, with very much interest, your theory of the vein formation of the Bunker Hill vein. As opportunities occur, I will take this matter up with Burch, and we will together examine the workings of the mine, with a view to preparing ourselves to testify in support of same.

I do not know where Lee is, but as soon as I get track of him, will ascertain whether or not he has his notes of the Stemwinder surface samples which he took. If he has not, I will have the work done again by Kennedy.
