Dear Sir,-

I enclose a sketch showing the line of the proposed flume to carry water to the Empire State millsite at the mouth of Government Gulch. Apparently it keeps to the O. R. & N. right of way until it strikes the land recently purchased from Jacquot. This may not be correct, as there are only occasional stakes to indicate the line. Also it will be noted that the point where the water is to be taken from the river does not conform to Page's notice, but rather conforms to Devlin's notice. I think the line is more than 100 feet south of the center of the O. R. & N. track, and in that case, it would be off the right of way of the railroad, and on ground belonging to us.
