Dear Sir,-

Since writing you this morning in regard to the proposed contract with the Butte and Ruby Valley Smelting Co. I have received your telegram of this date, saying "Let Rust take burden of disposing of our output". This, I think, is as it should be, but as the Secretary of the new smelting company was here yesterday looking for ore, I thought this was a favorable opportunity to help Rust out to some extent. I presume that Rust will understand from your letter of 29th ult. that he is expected to take care of our output up to the maximum tonnage agreed upon, and that unless he arranges with some other smelter to take part of the ore, and furnishes us with shipping directions accordingly, we shall send the ore to him. This ought to be fully understood as early as possible, because if Rust should fall down in any way on the proposition, it would leave us in an awkward predicament.
