Stalag Luft III. U.S. Army Air Force photo taken while prisoners were present there. Center Compound is second enclosure from top. Block 45, the Theater/Church, is immediately above-left of black square (fire pool). Barrack 52, where Chaplain Daniel lived during part of 1944 and January 1945, is immediately below-right of the black square. North Compound (British) is in center. The "Great Escape" tunnel started in the building, in the left row of barracks, went under the building paralleling the wire barricade, under the road, and emerged in the woods on left.

Stalag 7-A Moosburg. U.S. Army Air Force photo taken while camp was in use during the war. On the main street through the camp, in the lower left center of the compound, may be seen the open courtyard where Chaplain Daniel and his congregation gathered for worship on Sunday morning, April 29, 1945, when the liberating American 3rd Army began to take the camp by force. All church-goers prostrated themselves on the ground, not in worship, but in fear of stray bullets.
