# BRIEF HISTORY OF CCC CAMP F-45

May 1933 thru October 1933

LOCATION : St Joe National Forest, in NE4NE4 of Section 11, T42N, R3E, B.M.. About six miles east of Clarkia, Idaho on Gold Center Creek, about Amile east of where Gold Center Creek joins the Middle Fork of the St. Maries River.

#### PROJECTS:

- a. White Pine Blister Rust Control (primary project)
- Extended road(now #301) up ridge towards Windy Peak.
  Had one 1932 Cletrac dozer and all the rest of the road construction was done by hand.
- c. Started road south up the Middle Fork of St. Maries River, from the mouth of Gold Center Creek.
- d. Limited fire fighting (summer 1933 was a light fire year).

# MISCELLANEOUS DATA:

- a. Camp F-45 set up last week of May 1933 by a 25-man advance cadre from Fort Dix, New Jersey.
- b. Balance of enrolees arrived first week in June 1933 by a special train from Camp Dix, New Jersey to Clarkia, Idaho via the old Milwaukee R.R.
- c. Enrolees transported to camp in  $l\frac{1}{2}$  ton trucks from Clarkia, Idaho.
- d. Camp F-45 disbanded 3rd week in October 1933, when military overhead and enrolees left for a winter camp in the souteastern part of the U.S.. None of the civilian overhead went south.
