

New Ski Salalom Is Nearly Ready

**ANOTHER DAYS' WORK NEEDED
TO GIVE McCALL FINEST
COURSE IN WEST**

Two thousand feet of runway was cleared and partially burned for the new salalom course at the winter sports area last Sunday. The course is 100 feet wide. Sixty members of the Payette Lakes Ski club and several CCC boys co-operated to make a faster and longer salalom hill for this winter's skiing. According to Kaare Engen one more day of work will complete the course. The date has not been set definitely.

It is not yet certain whether or not the ski lift will be extended to run to the top of the new course. One hundred extra feet is all that is required, however the extra hike is not at all strenuous. The matter will be taken up by the Payette Lake Ski club.
