FOREST SERVICE SHOP IS ESTABLISHED IN CASCADE

The temporary transfer of supervising mechanic Morris N. Brown and mechanic Axel Jarvis to a central repair shop at Cascade was announced recently by Supervisor H. M. Shank.

A central shop for repair of all CCC equipment in southwest Idaho held by all agencies is being set up in Boise, but it is unlikely that the buildings will be completed before mid-summer. The Cascade arrangement is understood to be merely temporary until the Boise shop can begin to function fully.

Morris N. Brown for the present time will be supervising mechanic of all the equipment on the Idaho Payette, and Weiser forests. Axel Jarvis will take over the shop parts and clerical work incident to the setting up of the Cascade office.

Both men have been employed since 1933 on CCC equipment repair and maintenance on the Idaho National forest.
