

Road Over Secesh

Summit Now Open

The road over Secesh summit was opened last Saturday afternoon by a Forest Service road crew. A crew under Harold Vassar moved in Monday to maintain the road and the side roads, as far as the South Fork Ranger station. Another crew has started work on the Warren road beginning at Sylvan Beach. Crews from the CCC camp under Sup't Monte Cross have nearly completed betterment work on the road between Sylvan Beach and the end of the lake. This has been a much needed improvement including the widening of the road and the elimination of sharp, blind turns.

A crew of CCCs under forman Jesse Campbell are at present engaged in a spring planting on the cut over area north and east of the Winter Sports area. This crew will later do seeding of about one and one-quarter million trees at the McCall nursery, clean up of an additional six acres at the nursery, transplanting 100,000 seedlings in new seed beds and the construction of a small building housing tools, screens and other materials used at the nursery.
