## REDUCTION OF CCC ENROLLEES BEGIN THE FIRST OF APRIL

Director McEntee has announced that a gradual reduction in the enrolled strength of the CCC and the number of camps in operation will be initiated on April 1. The reductions have been ordered to bring the strength of the corps into line with the pending CCC appropriation bill which provides for the operation of 1,365 camps with a maximum enrollment of 273,000 exclusive of Indians and territorials during the 1942 fiscal year.

The operating program for the final quarter of the current fiscal year which began on April 1 provides for the operation of 1,473 camps as compared with 1,500 at present. The program also provides for a maximum enrollment of juniors and war veterans of 275,570 as compared with an authorized enrollment at present of 300,000, exclusive of 11,000 Indians and territorials. Additional camps will be closed in May and June as enrollees complete their training courses and obtain jobs in private industry.
