The civilian conservation corps program is being handicapped by the lack of enrollees, according to Director McEntee, who this week stated that the total number of camps may be reduced to about 1,050 on August 1, compared to 1,500 operated during the past fiscal year. A report just released by the CCC office states that Idaho's quota of 56 will be reduced to 35 camps, the forest service losing 14, the grazing division 5, and the reclamation bureau and the state park one each. The total grazing camps are reduced from 89 to 40. Total enrollees now number about 200,000, compared with 280,000 last year.
