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First of Forest Workers Soon To Arrive

The Forest Service and other government officials have finished plans and allocated camps for the advance guard of Reforestation workers which according to report is now on the way from eastern states and expected to arrive within the next three or four days.

About seven hundred men are expected to arrive with the first detachments.

According to present plans the Payette Forest will have ten camps to be located at Meadow Creek, Rustican, Stolle Meadows, Pen Basin, Third Fork, Profile Gap, Silver Creek and Gallagher and a state camp at Banks. It is also rumored here that there will be a state camp at Cabarton and one on Clear Creek.

In the Idaho Forest nine camps will be located at Lake Fork, Burgdorf, Stratton Creek, Paddy Flat, Big Creek, Goose Lake and Poverty Flat with state camps at Payette Lake and Bear Basin.

The Boise area is being furnished eighty-five trucks for use at the various camps.

A large crew of local men have been lined up to begin building camps at once.

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
