## VETERANS' ADMINISTRATION TO SELECT FOR CONSERVATION WORK

---

The responsibility for the selection of veterans for enrollment in the Emergency Conservation Work has been delegated to state managers of the Veterans Administration in accordance with Executive Order of the President, according to an announcement just released by G. H. Hudelson, Manager of the Veterans Administration for Idaho.

The quota of veterans to be selected in each state is based on the state population, as shown by the 1930 census. The quota for Idaho is 100 veterans.

Veterans who meet the following requirements and who submit properly prepared applications, in duplicate, are considered by the state managers of the Veterans Administration in making selections to fill the quotas established:

a. Service in the armed forces of

the quotas established:

- a. Service in the armed forces of the United States during the war
- b. Honorable discharge from such service
- c. Veteran is unemployed
- d. Veteran is citizen of the United States
- e. Physical fitness.

The application of a veteran for enrollment in the Civilian Conservation Corps requires four signatures to the endorsement. In securing these signatures the veteran should have with him a copy of his discharge certificate from the war in which he served and present it for review by those signing the endorsement.

Selections from applicants for enrollment will begin on June 12 and will be completed on or before June 19, Hudelson stated. When selections are made of veteran applicants, such veterans will be properly certified to the Area Commander of the Civilian Conservation Corps.

The enrollment of veterans will be accomplished by the War department under the direction and supervision of Colonel Charles L. Sampson, Area Commander of the Civilian Conservation Corps with headquarters at Boise Barracks, Boise, Idaho.
