

Idaho Joins Wet States in Repeal Election; Light Vote Cast

in the election Tuesday, with a margin of approximately, 14,000 votes out of a total of about 90,000 votes cast. Idaho is the 30th state to ratify. 36 states are needed to repeal, and no state voting has yet failed to ratify.

Valley County returns are not yet complete but indicate about a one-third vote with a leaning toward the repeal movement of about six to one.

The election chose 21 delegates to meet in convention at Boise October 17, to vote formally on ratification of the 21st Amendment which repeals the Eighteenth Amendment. This convention, however, is a mere formality and will in no wise change the result of the election as delegates are pledged to vote for ratification.

Idaho's liquor laws will not be so easy to erase as the National law, entailing a vote at the next general election in 1934 and then a wait of several months till the following session of the Legislature passes a measure repealing the Idaho prohibition enforcement statutes.
