The Idaho Relief Organization through Parker C. Carver, Administrator, puts out the following information on the question.

The Army will accept no enrollments until after the 15th of October and it is questionable whether there will be any enrollment of men at that time, due to the fact that the number of camps in this state are being reduced materially and they have been ordered to keep all of the Idaho men who signify willingness to stay this winter, which will, no doubt, crowd the camps which have been authorized, to the limit.
