

Fifty Men To Be Put On County Projects at Once

Fifty men and fifteen teams are to be put to work on four different projects by December 5, under the provisions of the civil works program, according to information given out today.

Of the four projects, one is a gravel job on the county road from McCall east. Another is graveling of the county road between Donnelly and Roseberry. Another is graveling of the Beaver Meadows road from the Van Wyck school north for two miles. The fourth project is the construction of three bridges in Round Valley.

This work is expected to last until February 15th, after which time other projects may be formulated.

Men for these projects will in the most part be procured close as possible to the work so that the workmen can remain at home and not have to board out or go into comp.
