IDAHO GETS SHARE OF FEDERAL ROAD FUND

Signing of the Hayden-Cartwright bill by President Roosevelt Monday will give Idaho \$2,243,125 for roads other than in the public domain and forests for the year beginning July 1 next, J. H. Stemmer, Idaho director of highways, said Monday.

In addition to the \$2,243,125 the state will receive \$132,500 for public domain roads and an unestimated amount for forest highways.

The total amount will be approximately one half of the amount Idaho received last year, Stemmer said.

If last year's set-up is followed 50 per cent of the funds for general road purposes will be for federal aid projects, 25 per cent for municipal highways and 25 per cent for secondary roads.
