NEW ENROLLMENT OF WAR VETERANS IN CCC WORK TO BEGIN AT ONCE

Boise.— Authority has been received to begin the enrollment of additional Idaho Spanish-American and World War veterans in the Civilian Conservation Corps, according to C. H. Huddelson, Manager of the Veterans' Administration Facility at Boise.

The enrollment will be continued from July 1st to 31st. Applications will be received immediately, announced Hudelson today. Any veteran who has completed one year in the corps is not eligible for re-enrollment. Any former enrollee who served any time other than during the last three months is not eligible for re-enrollment.

There is no age limit set but applicants are required to be physically fit to perform manual labor. It is probable that the veterans from southern Idaho will be sent to the veterans camp at Paris, Idaho, whereas veterans from northern Idaho will undoubtedly be sent to a camp in that area.

Interested veterans should communicate with the Manager, Veterans' Administration Facility, Boise, Idaho.
