ENROLLMENT OF VETERANS IN C. C. C. TO BEGIN EARLY IN OCTOBER

Boise—Information received by C. H. Hudelson, Manager of the Veterans' Administration Facility at Boise indicates that enrollment in the Civilian Conservation Corps for Idaho Spanish-American and World War veterans will begin early in October.

Applications will be received immediately from veterans interested and may be applied for by directing a communication to the Manager, Veterans' Administration Facility, Boise. The completed application must be returned by October 6th. There is no age limit set but applicants are required to be physically fit to perform manual labor. Any veteran who has formerly completed one year in the Corps is not eligible for reenrollment under present regulations.

Applications will be received from Veterans who have completed less than one year.

Information is not available as to where the veterans' camp will be located.
