EXTENSION GRANTED FOR ENROLLMENT OF VETERANS IN CCC

An extension of time has been granted for the enrollment of additional Idaho Spanish-American and World War veterans in the veteran's contingent of the Civilian Conservation Corps according to an announcement by C. H. Hudelson, Manager of the Veterans' Administration Facility at Boise. Applications must be received not later than May 7th to have favorable consideration.

All veterans interested should communicate immediately with the Veterans' Administration Facility at Boise.

Any veteran who was formerly enrolled in the Civilian Conservation Corps will not be eligible for enrollment according to present regulations. No age limit is set but applicants are required to be physically fit to perform manual labor. Each enrollee must allot a portion of his pay to dependents. If the veteran has no dependents, three-fourths of his monthly allowance will be withheld until such a time as he is discharged. The veterans from southern Idaho will probably be sent to the camp located at Paris, Idaho, whereas veterans from northern Idaho will probably be placed in a camp in that locality.
