National Geographic To Sponsor Salmon River Expedition

The National Geographic society has agreed to sponsor an expedition to explore the wilderness of the Salmon River country, from Salmon City to Lewiston, rated the least explored area in the United States.

While details of the project are not known, it was announced that several scientists will accompany the expedition and a thorough study will be made of the geology, plant and animal life of the area, probably requiring several months.

The ancient Indian rock writings along the Salmon and tributary creeks will be studied and recorded to trace the history of Idaho's first inhabitants.

The expedition will be completely equipped and still and moving pictures will be recorded of all interesting objects. Early settlers along the river will be interviewed in an effort to acquire a complete background of history of the primitive area.

The expedition will travel more than 200 miles from Salmon to Lewiston, through the mile-deep trench dug by the "River of No Return." With the exception of the Snake it is the deepest and most awesome canyon on the continent.—Emmett Index.
