Idaho Asks 20 Million From Government For Work Relief

With eight million dollars already promised by the works progress administration for projects in Idaho, J. L. Hood, state WPA administrator, Wednesday laid preliminary plans for works projects which will, when finished, cost an estimated total of 20 million dollars, the sum asked for from the federal government.

In a round-figure breakdown of the WPA funds, Hood pointed out that the state highway program will cost approximately four million dollars, and the water program, which includes dams, canals and other irrigation projects will be allotted an estimated total of \$4,700,000.

Other general programs and estimates of funds to be used are: Mine-to-road, one million dollars; noxious weeds, \$1,600,000; fish and game, 500 thousand dollars; drainage, \$1,500,000, and airports, one million dollars.

As a preliminary step toward removing all clients from relief rolls, 47 WPA projects have already been started and will cost \$434,547.

Five hundred sixty-seven persons, including men and women, have been taken from relief rolls and put to work under the WPA program.
