

## RELIEF WORKERS BENEFIT THRU NATIONAL REEMPLOYMENT SERVICE

Three-fold benefits to the relief client are embodied in the recent stat-wide order that every employable person on IERA rolls must be registered with the National Employment Service before receiving relief, A. W. Jacomini, Assistant Administrator of the Idaho Emergency Relief Administration states.

First, in order to qualify for a place in the Works Progress Administration the relief client must have a registration card bearing the stamp of the NRS. Second, in order to receive work in any other phase of the federal program he must be likewise registered and Third, to secure the services of the National Reemployment agency with the possible placement on a private job, he must of course be on NRS lists, officials advise.

Jacomini emphasized the fact that the words, "National Reemployment Service" mean much more than the title of any ordinary employment agency. The Service has been built around the idea of having the government act as a go-between for

the unemployed and employer, who must wait with the offer of work. IERA officials have pointed out the fact, in this connection, that relief workers are not to be seriously affected by the employment through relief standing.

## AVERAGE PRICE IDAHO FARM PRODUCTS

Boise, Idaho, (Special) — The index of prices for farm commodities in Idaho points due mainly to the fact of being received for the month according to the Bureau of Average Farm Products, Richard C. Ross, agricultural economist. The general index received by Idaho farm products on September 15, 1934, is 109 per cent of the 1914-16 average.

Grain prices were notably higher during the month ending September 15, but a decline in fruits and other crops more than offset the gain made by grain. That the index fell one point from 109 to 108 is due to the decline in the price of apples.

The general index of prices at 109 per cent is 6 points higher than the index of the main commodities.
