W. P. A. WORKERS MUST HAVE HAD RELIEF PRIOR TO NOV. 1, 1935

A new ruling sent out to the various Relief Agencies throughout the nation by the Federal Emergency Relief Administration at Washington D. C., has made necessary slight changes in procedure for the Idaho Emergency Relief Administration and the Works Progress Administration. Notices have just been received by these two offices from Harry L. Hopkins, Federal Administrator, stating that relief workers, in order to receive employment in the Works Progress Administration Program, must have been on the relief rolls previous to November 1, 1935.

Under this ruling only those workers who were on the relief rolls previous to November 1st can be certified by the IERA as eligible for work on WPA projects.

In clarifying this ruling, A. W. Jacomini, Assistant Administrator of the Idaho Emergency Relief Administration said, "In order to become eligible for work on the Works Progress Administration Program one must have been receiving relief from the IERA previous to November 1st of this year. Our Administration certifies to this fact to the National Reemployment Service, which, in turn, fills the need for men and women on the WPA projects at the request of the Labor Management Division of the WPA. It is not possible for men or women to secure the Security Wage in any Federal Program who have not had this certification.
