1159 TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS

Boise, April 22—(UP)— Expected number of claims in Idaho for lump-sum payments under the federal old-age benefits plan of the social security act was set at 1159 today by regional offices in Denver, Colorado.

Officials estimated that in the six states comprising the 11th district, approximately 11,000 persons or estates would be eligible for either lump-sum or death payments.

States included in the district are Colorado, Wyoming, Montana, Idaho, Utah and Arizona.

Approximately \$6,000,000 will be paid to an estimated number of 323,684 persons or their estates in the United States this year, it was announced by the social security board in Washington.

The board estimates that during 1937, for each person in covered employment who attains the age of 65, two others will die before reaching that age. Thus, it was explained, two death claims are expected to be filed for each age payment requested.

Lump sums now payable in Idaho amount to three and one half per cent of the total wages received by the individual in covered employment after 1936. Lump-sum payments are made to those persons in covered employment who, at the age of 65, fail to qualify for monthly benefits either because they have not received an included wage total of at least \$2000 or because wages have not been paid them for employment in each of 5 calendar years after December 31, 1936, and before the age of 65.
