# EMERGENCY PROGRAMS IN IDAHO If. LAST TWO YEARS BRING IN 

 $\$ 43,389,624$ FOR STATEBoise, May 6-(UP) - Emergency programs in Idaho during the last two years brought $\$ 43,389,624$ to the state for a period ending March 31, W. T. Lockwood, director of the national emergency council, said this week.

There was an unexpended balance in funds provided in emergency relief acts of 1935 and 1936 totaling more than $\$ 4,000,000$, he said.

Funds expended included, $\$ 6,-$ $059,828.46$ for highways, roads. and streets; public buildings, $\$ 1,028$,465.50 ; public recreational facilities. $\$ 688,157.43 ; \quad \$ 21,009,056.63$ for conservation; $\$ 1,176,624.92$ for educational projects, and $\$ 645,042.25$ for electric, water and sewage systems.
