GRANT IS NOT LOST

Boise (AP)—A \$96,400 public works administration grant, intended to aid Idaho in constructing a \$208,000 state tuberculosis hospital, is not yet lost, Governor Barzilla W. Clark declared this week.

The governor, who has applied to PWA for a second extension of the grant, said he was "assured that there would be no adverse action without further consideration' of his application.

"We might be able to prolong the grant until after the next session of the legislature," he said.
