Forest Man Hurt In Fall From Pole; Flown To Boise

Carl H. Johnson, 21, guard at the Elk Creek ranger station on Payette National Forest, was seriously injured Monday morning when he fell from a tree while repairing telephone line near Deadwood Mine.

After preliminary examination by a CCC physician at Warm Lake revealed a head injury, Johnson was rushed to Boise by plane. Penn Stohr, pilot of Johnson Flying Service, hustled a ship to Landmark, the nearest landing field.

The flight to Boise was made in one hour and 14 minutes. Auto travel time is more than five hours.

Shortly after the accident was reported to Thomas Van Meter, Payette forest supervisor in Boise, the telephone line went dead. Communications were carried on by radio.

Johnson was taken to Veterans' Hospital where physicians reported severe bruises about the face, including a broken nose and a concussion threatening sight of the right eye; a broken elbow, and a cut on the lower lip. Johnson was conscious when he reached Boise. He said he was hurt by falling from a horse, but his companion on the 'phone string job said it was a fall from a tree into a pile of rocks.

The injured man is a son of J. H. Johnson of Caldwell, state highway engineer in charge of Bogus Basin highway construction.
