TRAIN BURNED

A fire which stopped traffic and delayed the train, stage and telephone service between Cascade and Boise was started Thursday around noon. one mile north of Banks. The fire was said to have been started from the down going train. The fire had spread to such an ex-

tent that by evening the forest service had approximately 1000 fire fighters en route to the fire. Ferncroft Lodge, which has been

recently remodeled, new cabins added and under new management, is in direct line of the fire and at the time of going to press the fire was about one mile from the lodge. Saving of the lodge depends on the weather conditions during the afternoon. The north bound train Thursday

evening reached Cascade with a number of cars scorched, the stock cars being on fire three times to such an extent that the trainmen had to stop and extinguish the fire.

This is the wirst fire that the Payette National Forest has had this season and in one of the prettiest drives in this part of Idaho. At noon today the fire had covered around
