According to word received today from L. T. Vaughn, manager of the stamp issuing office, \$4,500 worth of orangecolored stamps was sold the first two days of the month.

"Grocers who have not yet signed the official retailer statement forms, necessary before stamps can be redeemed by the Treasury Department, are requested to write this office and the official set of Food Stamps instructions will be sent them, Willard Walter, area supervisor, said today. He also announced hat the counties of Payette, Gem, Washington, Adams, Nez Perce, Clearwater, Lewis and Idaho would be opened next, with preliminary work starting this week.
