Prison Camp At Smith's Ferry Opens January 1

The Idaho Prison Board has approved the establishment of a prison camp at Smith's Ferry, Idaho under plans submitted to them by State Forester Girard some several months ago.

The camp site is in the heart of a beautiful forested mountain country on the banks of the Payette River and is situated on a large tract of valuable land deeded to the state of Idaho by action of S. G. Moon, general manager of the Boise Payette Lumber Company.

During the last several months construction of suitable native log dormitories, a mess hall, recreation rooms and other adequate housing facilities have been completed and it is expected that the first group of prisoners will be quartered here by January 1.

The prisoners will be assigned to various seasonal tasks, chief among them being—propagation of suitable trees for reforestation and erosion control and all phases of fire suppression and presuppression control.
