SUBJECT: Memorandum from CCC Division, HNCA

TO : All Company Commanders, Pocatello District, CCC

The following Office Memorandum, received from CCC Division, HNCA, is quoted for your information:

"Since Congress has appropriated \$8,000,000.00 for liquidation of the CCC over a period of one year, and since no definite information relative a termination date has been received, operation of this office for an indefinite period is contemplated. It is important, perhaps imperative, that personnel of this office be retained intact until dissolution of the CCC in the Ninth Corps Area has progressed sufficiently that some may be released without detriment to the job to be done. However, as soon as definite information relative termination of the CCC in the Ninth Corps Area is received, every possible effort will be made by the CCC Executive and members of the Staff to secure positions for all personnel, without loss in grade or change in general location, in other branches of the War Department and/or other departments of the Federal Government. Present conditions indicate that such a plan would be successful. Consequently, it is suggested that all personnel "sit tight" until definite information is received."
