

Dear Mr. Larsen:

Enclosed is a copy of Inspector Akridge's report and copy of a letter received from the Regional Forester. As stated in this letter, report indicates a well managed camp. However, the following items need to be followed up:

A.15.a. and B.3.a. As stated in the report, the crew formation, supervision and class of work were discussed in detail at the camp. The changes necessary to secure better results were planned. A follow-up on these should be made to make sure that the best possible results are obtained.

A.25. The enrollees assigned to the Experimental Station can be used to mow the lawn and take care of the office. They cannot be used for making beds and taking care of the bunkhouse. The enrollees can be used to procure wood for the administration buildings, but not for the families stationed there. Where wood is procured by the enrollees and used by families stationed there, it will be necessary for them to reimburse the government according to the established policy. More information is necessary in regard to this. When this is secured, it will be taken up with Director Bradner.

A.26. Newcomb, Swanson, Maryott and Rivers have accumulated considerable annual leave. Plans will be made to have most of this taken when the fire season is over.

B-1. More detailed information will be obtained from Bentley on the experimental projects.

B-2.a. A check-up will be made to determine what specifications and instructions are lacking. These will be reported to the Supervisor's office and they will be furnished.

D-22.a. A check-up will be made on the enrollees who are required to have first aid cards.

E-1 and E-12. A check will be made to see that the project crews are listed and the list of those unfit for fire duty is up-to-date. The commissary box as recommended, will be taken up with the Commanding officer. This box will be made available for fire use.

F-16. If it is impossible to get the Company Commander to make the garbage pit fly proof, the circumstances and facts should be reported to this office.

H-7. Mechanic Swanson will be consulted in regard to equipping pickups with rear railing or chains.

H-10. Reference is made to the last paragraph of Mr. Webb's letter with regard to Fort George Wright providing the items necessary to bring the first aid kits up to CCC specifications. If this cannot be done, a requisition should be made for the necessary items.

H-13. The gasoline filler tank must be kept locked.
